[Apartheid Free Zone since December 2025]

The Dok -in her current form as a Social and a Cultural AFZ- takes the commitment to cut off any kind of support to Israel's genocidal apartheid regime, by continuing to learn and be self reflective as a collective, bettering ourselves guided by the mission of the BDS-campagne.

What is an Apartheid Free Zone?

The Apartheid Free Zone (AFZ) is a BDS international campaign which goal is to create a community of spaces *-both virtual and physical-* that take concrete actions to cut commercial, institutional, cultural and political connections with the Israeli apartheid regime. The campaign is promoted by BDS, a Palestinian-led international movement that calls for Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions against Israel policies of occupation, colonization and apartheid.

This campaign is inspired by the struggle against apartheid in South Africa, and is currently active in several countries around the world like Belgium, the UK, Chile, United States, Morocco, Switzerland, Brazil, Greece, Norway, Spain, and Italy.

What does this mean for the Plantage Dok?

We welcome initiatives in support of social justice and Palestinian solidarity, educational events on Palestinian rights, and programs that amplify marginalized voices. We welcome initiatives that promote Palestinian heritage and culture as yet another form of nonviolent resistance.

Boycott products

We ensure *-as a space in which products are used and processed-* that we do everything we can to not use any products from illegal Israeli settlements or from any Israeli or international company that profits from violations of Palestinian human rights.

Boycott initiatives that support Israeli policies

We ensure *-as a space for events and social interactions-* that we do not support any initiative that promotes, legitimizes or normalizes Israeli policies violating international law, including apartheid, occupation, and illegal settlements.

We ensure *-as a space committed to promote critical thinking and exchange-* that we do not participate in or promote any individual/activity/project/event that in any way legitimizes or normalizes Israeli apartheid [in accord with the **PACBI-guidelines**].
